2. M/Glen, S/Woody, U to approve agenda.

3. No public present.

4. m/ Whitcomb, s/Glen, U to adopt minutes of April 6.

5. Discussion of implementation of 2015 Work Plan.

Discussion and consideration of the items on the agenda. Consensus agreement to proceed with general approach as outlined in committee report in packet: one brochure focused on neighborhood watch type activities and one with more general theme of 'shared responsibility'. Glen presented a draft brochure on Neighborhood Watch. Much discussion about whether to make it about the formal Neighborhood Watch program or more generic 'neighbors looking out for neighbors' with NW as one way to do that. Consensus to revise to a more generic approach, based on observation that there is some resistance to formal NW in Blue Lake and the brochure may reach a wider audience if we don't call it that. Comm Mann will work on revision.

More general brochure and poster will:

Encourage reporting of suspicious activity or crimes.

What is suspicious activity

How to call, emphasis on the Sheriff is available 24/7 in BL and calling Sheriffs Office in Eureka is the fastest way to get in touch with our local deputies

How to report, how to describe, what to look for.

Committee of Whitcomb/Woody will go through currently available info to pull out most important parts addressing these issues.

6. Activity reports were reviewed. Council Liaison McCall Wallace reported that she met with Sheriff's reps. They explained that all items on the Call for Service list provided to Commission are addressed in some manner. If a full case is opened on an item, a case number appears. The Sheriff agreed to add time of call or incident to the reports in the future.

7. Announcements, Commissioner Lin Glen announced her resignation, with this meeting being her last.

8. Council liaison read a letter from Sheriff indicating that Deputy Julia Oliveira will be reassigned to another location, Deputy Scott Aponte will be moving into the vacated weekday shift and a new deputy will be assigned for weekend nights. The Commission made suggestions for characteristics desired in the new deputy for the Council to communicate to the Sheriff.

9. Because of known absences, the next meeting shall be on Monday July 13 instead of July 5.

The Commission requests that new members receive a packet of materials including a copy of the Sheriff's Contract, the current year Work Plan, the relevant pages from the City's Strategic Plan, and results of the most recent annual meeting.
