TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All work on City of Blue Lake rights-of-way or easements shall comply with the following terms and conditions:

1. Barricades must be kept on all trenches, excavations and obstructions. Warning lights must be maintained at night. All signs, flags, lights, and other warning and safety devices shall conform to the requirements set forth in the current "Manual of Warning Signs, Lights and Other Devices for Use in Performance of Work Upon Highways" issued by the State of California Department of Public Works. Continuous vehicle and pedestrian access shall be maintained unless specifically otherwise permitted on the Encroachment Permit.
2. Access to fire hydrants shall be maintained at all times.
3. No street shall be closed without first notifying the Blue Lake Fire Department at 668-5765 and the Blue Lake City Clerk at 668-5655 at least 24 hours in advance. An estimate shall be given on how long the closure is expected to last and notification shall again be given when the street is reopened.
4. Refused or unused materials shall be removed from street areas within three (3) days after completion of the work.
5. All work shall be guaranteed for a period of one year from the date of acceptance. Failure of the City to detect flaws in the work shall not relieve the applicant and/or contractor of this responsibility.
6. Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit in its entirety will result in the City performing the necessary work at the applicant's expense.
7. Any long-term encroachment not properly or promptly maintained will be repaired or removed at the applicant's expense.
8. The applicant shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Blue Lake, its officers and agents, from all suits or action of every name and description brought for, or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or persons, brought by or from the applicant, his servants or agents, in the construction of the work, or by or in consequence of any negligence in guarding the same, or for improper materials used in construction.
9. No permit will be issued to any individual, organization, or contractor who has outstanding fees, charges, or work not in compliance with terms of any permit issued.
10. Permit will expire on the date specified for completion.
11. This permit is subject to all provisions contained in the City's Encroachment Permit Regulations (Ordinance #312).
