Interim Policy Pertaining to Release of Sewer Capacity

As of September 24, 2013, the City of Blue Lake has unallocated sewer capacity equal to one hundred (100) residential equivalent units (REU's). Sixty (60) residential equivalent units are reserved for residential connections which includes both single and multi-family uses. Forty (40) REU's are available at this time for non-residential use. Non-residential uses, demanding capacity, equal to or less than one (1) REU, may be approved by the City Manager. Capacity requests for non-residential uses beyond one (1) REU shall be approved by the City Council. This policy shall remain in effect until modified by the City Council. Adopted: September 24, 2013
