

**NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMISSION TO THE CLITY CLERK OF
ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST A CITY OF BLUE LAKE MEASURE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal election shall be held on November 8, 2022, at which there will be submitted to the voters of the City the following measure:

Essential Services Tax Measure	
To maintain and improve essential services, including public safety services, shall the City of Blue Lake measure to levy a one percent sales tax, raising approximately \$25,000 annually, until repealed, with independent annual audits and all funds remaining in Blue Lake, be adopted?	Yes

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure.


NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **Friday, August 19, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.** as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, in the City Clerk's Office, located at 111 Greenwood Ave, Blue Lake, CA 95525.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, may be filed in the City Clerk's Office, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, no later than **Monday, August 26, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.** The signers may be different persons than the persons who signed the primary arguments.

Primary arguments and rebuttal arguments shall be signed by not more than five persons.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the measure, arguments, and impartial analysis will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis.

Notice is hereby given that a general municipal election will be held in the City of Blue Lake on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2022, for the following officers:


