4. Blue Lake Branding & Signage Project -Update and Discussion ~ City Manager Mager provided a status update. Working with Noah Samson, Visual Concepts, to develop a Blue Lake brand, focusing on recreation activities. He will create a logo which can be used across all media platforms, etc.

Jean Lynch, commented, if Blue Lake is going to be a recreation area, there needs to be signage directing people to river, trails, Perigot Park, dog walking, parking, etc. Currently people are parking on Greenwood, which is not pedestrian friendly.

Commissioner Hussin stated signage is important. Maybe put together a trail map/brochure.

5. Spring Event Programming ~ City Manager Mager provided an update on the upcoming spring events. Parks and Recreation are launching a lot of programs ~ drop-in basketball, pickle ball, Karaoke Nights, Barn Dance, skating etc. Fine tuning the sound system.

- **6.** City of Blue Lake Project Updates ~ City Manager Mager provided the following updates.
 - a. Town Square Construction Project ~ Construction scheduled to begin in the spring, depending on the weather. Putting in the plumbing for the splash fountain pad and bathrooms, landscaping and benches. The bathroom cost came in too high. One temporary idea is to install ADA accessible porta potties placed in a covered area. The potties could be decorated (designed wrap around) to improve the appearance. Potties would be provided and maintained by B+B Portale Toilets.

b. Sports Complex Development Concept ~ City Manager Mager presented a new concept for future consideration as part of the Baduwa't Community Project. The new architect, Garett McSorley, expressed the real need in Humboldt County for an inside/outside sports complex. There is a shortage of places to hold sporting events, and practice space. This type of project could fit into Blue Lake's recreation destination branding.
